

**Report on the activities of Małgorzata Borówko during her visit to the Institute of Condensed Matter of Ukrainian Academy of Sciences in Lviv.**

The visit took place between 20 May and 19 June of 2011.

1. On May 26 I gave a seminar on adsorption on surfaces modified with end-grafted polymers.
2. I attended the workshop organized by the Institute for young scientists from the Ukraine as well as the seminar given by A. Patrykiewicz.
3. Over the entire period of the visit I discussed several problems connected with the project with the members of the host Institute. In particular the discussions have been devoted to the following topics: theory and applications of chromatography with chemically bonded phases, the implementation of dissipative particle dynamics method to nonuniform systems involving polymers.
4. During the visit I also worked on adsorption from solutions on polymer-tethered surfaces and discussed some aspects of that work with the members of the host Institute.
